

J&L's Guide For Estimating Flower, Groundcover, & Shrub Quantities

Measure your area, Determine your spacing, and this chart will help you decide how many plants you need.

Spacing	10 square feet (5' x 2')	25 square feet (5' x 5')	50 square feet (5' x 10')	100 square feet (10' x 10')
6"	40	100	200	400
10"	15	37.5	75	150
12"	10	25	50	100
18"	4.5	12	23	45
24"	2.5	6.5	12.5	25
30"	1.5	4	8	16
36"	1	2.5	5.5	11
4'	1	1.5	3	6
5'	1	1	2	4

Example: 10' x 10' area = 100 square feet

Flowers planted 6" apart.

20 rows of 20 flowers = 400 flowers

Flowers planted 12" apart

10 rows of 10 flowers = 100 flowers

Flowers planted 24" apart

5 rows of 5 flowers = 25 flowers
